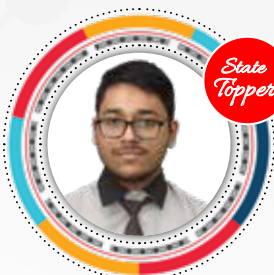

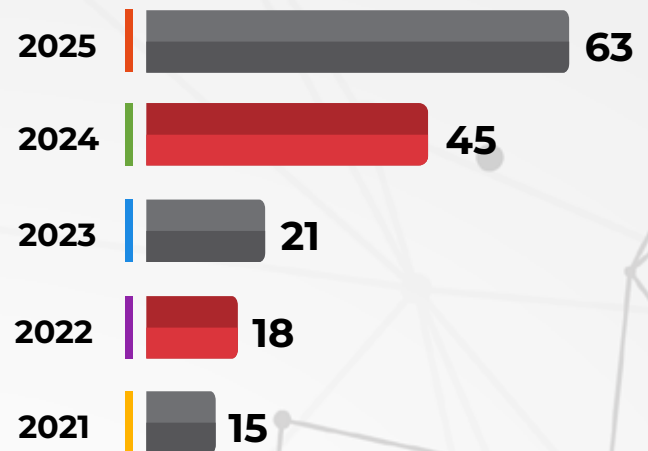

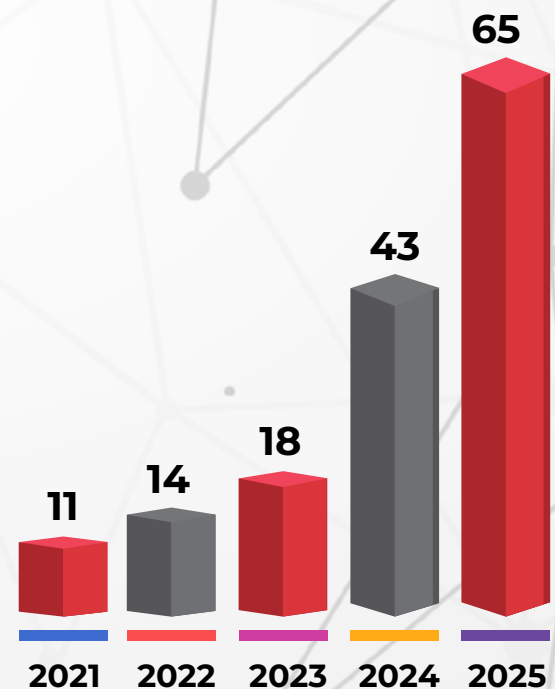

Important Terms & Conditions - About Fees

- i. Admission Fees or Provisional Admission Fees/Enrollment Fees - is non-refundable once admission/enrollment is done
- ii. In case, school cancels admission on any grounds, school will refund the Admission/Provisional Admission Fees/ Enrollment Fees by deducting a specific charge as mentioned in the Terms & Condition Document
- iii. School fees has to be paid on time as per installment/quarter plan.

Admission in Mid-Session/Change of Plans
